



ORDINANCE NO. 529

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 45 TO INCREASE THE TERMS OF OFFICE ON THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING BOARD FROM TWO (2) YEARS TO THREE (3) YEARS.

SECTION II. MEMBERSHIP AND APPOINTMENT: The Council on Aging Board shall be composed of nine (9) members to be appointed by County Council. Each appointment shall be for three (3) years, except that during the next appointment cycle for each vacancy on the Board, as would have occurred otherwise during the normal course of the appointment process, prior to that appointment, the Chair, in consultation with the Clerk to Council, shall set a special term length for the appointment cycle for each vacancy so as to create an appointment schedule such that approximately one-third of the Board's seats are subject to appointment each year.

If a vacancy occurs, the Council shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term. A person selected to serve on any board or commission is not eligible to serve more than two Terms during any three-term period. For purposes of this subitem, the service of any portion of a full term is considered service of a "Term" for purposes of determining whether a person is eligible for re-appointment. However, a person is always eligible to be appointed to the same board or commission after an absence from the board or commission for a period equal to one full term of service.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND EXECUTION BY THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL.
