AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 53 TO REDUCE THE TERMS OF OFFICE ON THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS FROM FOUR (4) YEAR TERMS TO THREE (3) YEAR TERMS

SECTION 1

CREATION AND APPOINTMENT: There is hereby created the Fairfield County Board of Assessment Appeals which shall consist of seven (7) members to be appointed by the Fairfield County Council. The members of the Board shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years; provided that, the terms shall be staggered in the initial appointment by appointing four members to three (3) year terms and three members to two (2) year terms.

If a vacancy occurs, the Council shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term. Persons selected to fill positions shall be eligible to serve no more than two consecutive terms. Any portion of the term is considered a whole term.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND EXECUTION BY THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL.
