AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 335 TO REDUCE THE TERMS OF OFFICE ON THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS FROM FOUR (4) YEAR TERMS TO THREE (3) YEAR TERMS

SECTION 9-9

ESTABLISHMENT OF BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS: A Board of Zoning Appeals is hereby established. Said Board shall consist of five (5) members, who shall be citizens of the County, and shall be appointed by County Council for terms of three (3) years, staggered so that one-third of the members shall have terms expiring in each year.

If a vacancy occurs, the Council shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term. Persons selected to fill positions shall be eligible to serve no more than two consecutive terms. Any portion of the term is considered a whole term.

Any member may be removed by the County Council for cause, after a public hearing. Members shall serve without pay, but may be reimbursed for any expenses incurred while representing the Board.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND EXECUTION BY THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL.
