AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2014 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE (NEC) AS THE MANDATORY ELECTRICAL CODE FOR FAIRFIELD COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, All local jurisdictions must adopt the mandatory building codes as required by the South Carolina State Statute 6-9-10 and 6-9-50; and

WHEREAS, The South Carolina Building Codes Council has adopted the required mandatory building codes for the State of South Carolina as authorized by South Carolina State Statute 6-9-60(B); and

WHEREAS, The mandatory electrical code is the 2014 edition of the National Electric Code (NEC); and

WHEREAS, All local jurisdictions were to adopt the new mandatory building codes by July 1, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL THAT:

The Fairfield County Council adopts the National Electric Code (NEC) 2014 edition as the mandatory electrical code for all design, installation, erection, alteration, addition to, replacement, workmanship, construction, maintenance or repair or installation of electrical systems, equipment and components indoors and outdoors that are within the scope of this code as defined in Article 90-2 of the NEC 2014 Code, including services, power distribution systems, fixtures, appliances, devices and appurtenances that are within the jurisdiction of the County of Fairfield.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND EXECUTION BY THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COUNCIL.
