



Ordinance No. 761

An Ordinance to Amend the Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2020, and Ending June 30, 2021, and Authorizing the Supplemental Appropriation of Funds for Increased Fire Services.

WHEREAS, Fairfield County Council adopted and enacted Ordinance No. 741, Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget; and

WHEREAS, Fairfield County Council desires to make a supplemental appropriation and to amend the above referenced Ordinance for certain purposes, including:

An appropriation of Funds from the enactment of new funds relating to Increased Fire Services.

NOW, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by Fairfield County Council as follows:

1. The total revenues for the operating budget for the current fiscal year, beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021 ("2020-21 Fiscal Year"), are \$46,646,959; \$38,015,689 general fund and \$8,631,270 all other funds. For 2020-21 fiscal year, the total expenditures for the operating budget are \$46,646,959; \$38,015,689 general fund and \$8,631,270 all other funds.
2. The line item for 404-141-5706.01 New Building Construction is increased by \$200,000 to provide for increased fire services to the citizens of Fairfield County.
3. That the Supplemental Appropriations provided for by this ordinances are hereby appropriated as part of the Fairfield County Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2020, and Ending June 30, 2021, and incorporated therein for the purposes stated, and except as amended the Budget Ordinance No. 741 is reaffirmed.
