

3. Ensure that parts of the districts are contiguous;
4. Respect Communities of Interest;
5. Attempt to maintain constituent consistency;
6. Solicit, public input.


SECTION 7. The County Administrator is authorized and directed to take such administrative actions to promulgate and execute such procedures and policies as may be necessary or desirable to carry into effect and implement the redistricted single-member-election districts provided for in this Ordinance, including the elections required thereby and in accordance with any directions, suggestions, or objectives of the Civil Rights Division, U.S. Department of Justice, after submission to it of this Ordinance and all required materials.

SECTION 8. The County Attorney is hereby directed to compile and submit the appropriate documentation to all superior agencies as soon as possible.

SECTION 9. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance are held invalid, the validity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are separable.


SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall take effect upon third reading.
